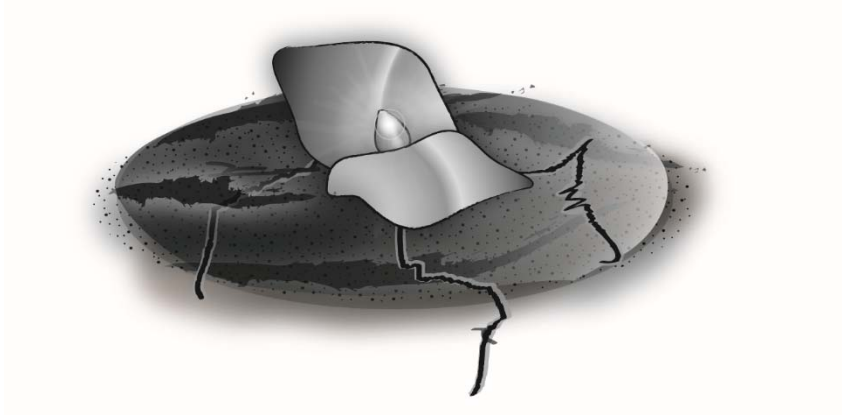


# Changeless Change
